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OPENING GENERAL SESSION

Keynote Speaker



Dr. John W. Hodge is President and Co-founder of Urban Learning and Leadership Center (ULLC), an organization focused on student achievement and reduction of the achievement gap. He has served as a reading teacher, English teacher, AVID teacher, Assistant Principal and Associate Director of AVID Center Eastern Division. He served as Director of An Achievable Dream Academy, an inner city school that piloted many of the interventions used by Urban Learning and Leadership Center. An Achievable Dream Academy is a high performing, high poverty school that has received numerous national awards. Dr. Hodge received his Bachelor of Science degree from North Carolina A&T State University and his Master of Arts degree from Chapman University. He earned his Doctor of Education degree from Virginia Tech where he conducted extensive research on factors that contribute to the academic success and/or failure of impoverished children. What sets Dr. Hodge apart in the field of education is his well-documented ability to put research and theory into everyday practice in rural, urban, and suburban schools. He is truly one of America's most respected new voices in education.

RESEARCH PRESENTATION

Keynote Speaker



Dr. Amy M. Wetherby is a Distinguished Research Professor in the Department of Clinical Sciences and Director of the Autism Institute in the College of Medicine and the Laurel Schendel Professor of Communication Disorders at Florida State University. She has thirty years of clinical experience and is a fellow of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association. Dr. Wetherby is the Project Director of a Doctoral Leadership Training Grant specializing in autism funded by the U.S. Department of Education. She served on the National Academy of Sciences Committee for Educational Interventions for Children with Autism and is the Executive Director of the Florida State University Center for Autism and Related Disabilities. Dr. Wetherby is the Project Director of the FIRST WORDS Project, a longitudinal research investigation on early detection of autism spectrum and other communication disorders, funded by the U.S. Department of Education, National Institutes of Health, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Dr. Debbie Silver is a former Louisiana Teacher of the Year, a best-selling author, and a highly acclaimed national and international speaker. She has presented in 49 states, Europe, Asia, Africa, Australia, Canada, Mexico and the Middle East. Dr. Silver's best-selling books include: *Drumming to the Beat of Different Marchers*, *Fall Down 7 Times - Get Up 8*, *Deliberate Optimism: Reclaiming the Joy in Education*, and her recently released *Teaching Kids to Thrive: Essential Skills for Success*. She is a multiple award-winning educator who has taught almost every grade level and every kind of student along the way. Dr. Silver's high-energy keynote addresses both the art and heart of teaching. Her extensive research background gives her keen insights into educational theory and practice, while her trademark humor and candor help her connect with all those involved in education. Audiences delight in hearing this 30-year veteran teacher whose presentations are described as "where learning collides with laughter."

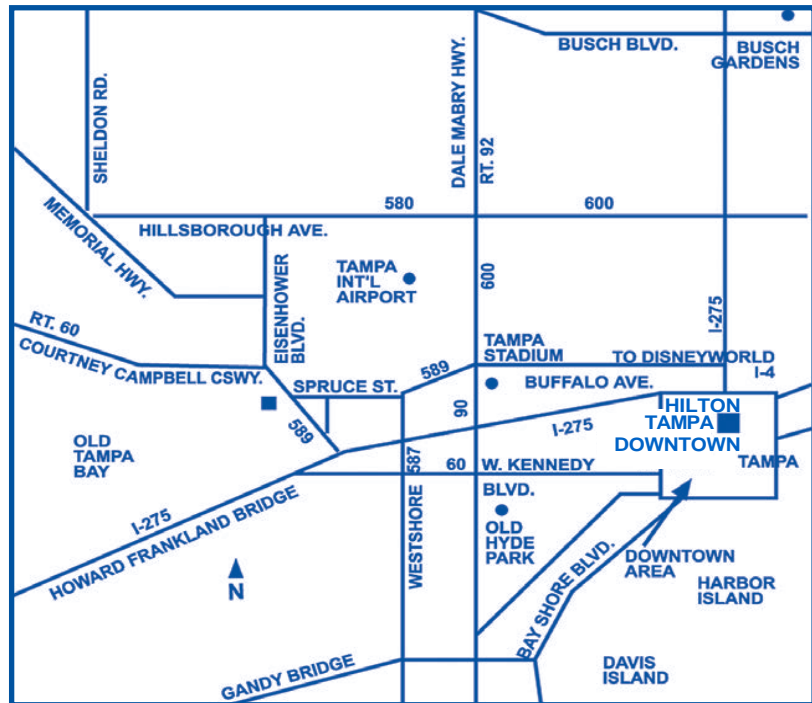
