Keynote Speakers Opening General Session



Dr. Melissa L. Baralt began her career as a primary school teacher in Maracaibo, Venezuela. She then attended Georgetown University in Washington, D.C. to study how the brain acquires language and what teachers, caregivers, and parents can do to maximize the language learning process. At Florida International University, Dr. Baralt

has two key roles: language teacher trainer and psycholinguistics researcher. Some of her research areas: Psycholinguistics, Bilingualism and second language acquisition, Bilingual language development in children, Sociocultural and Environmental factors that affect parent-child interaction, Bilingual education, Methodologies of language teaching, Language teacher education and cognition. Dr. Baralt will share in her keynote the Role of Caregiver Speech in Child Development: What Every Educator Should Know.

Holly Elissa Bruno, best-selling and award-winning author, international keynote speaker, and podcaster. She served as Assistant Attorney General for the state of Maine and Assistant Dean at the University of Maine School of Law. An alumna of Harvard University's Institute for Educational

Management, she teaches leadership courses for Wheelock College, most recently in Singapore. Bruno has written several books; her current writing focuses on transforming childhood trauma into healing wisdom and finding hope in unbearable times. She will share the importance of You in her keynote, "Hats Off to You: Everyday Miracle Workers in Children's Lives."
